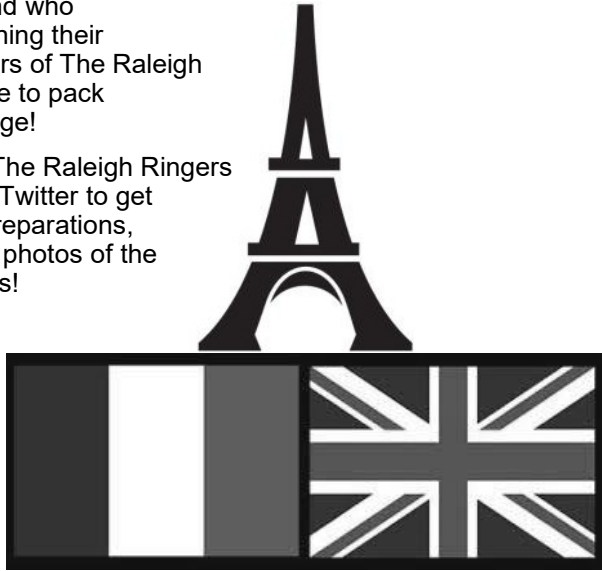

The tour kicks off in Paris, France at the American Church in Paris to celebrate Fred Gramann's 40th anniversary as their Director of Music. From there, The Raleigh Ringers will travel to Compiègne, France (one of Raleigh's sister cities!) and then end the tour in London, England.

Anyone who has seen The Raleigh Ringers in concert before knows that the performance requires quite a bit of equipment - how in the world to get 29 1/2 octaves of bells and bell-like instruments all the way over to France? Thanks to Fred Gramann, Keith Rowland, and the folks at the Whitechapel Bell Foundry of England who are graciously loaning their bells sets, members of The Raleigh Ringers won't have to pack bells in their luggage!

Drop off and pick up your own bells

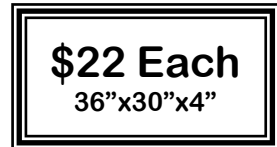
