

THE RALEIGH RINGERS COVID-19 HEALTH ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

This document contains important information about the COVID-19 public health crisis. Our decisions are based in part on recommendations by the Centers for Disease Control, State of North Carolina, Wake County and City of Raleigh protocols, and considerations of the location and environment.

Please read this carefully and let a member of The Raleigh Ringers know if you have any questions. When you check the box on the registration form, it will be an official agreement between you and The Raleigh Ringers.

Risks of Opting for In-Person Services

You understand that by participating, you are assuming the risk of exposure to the coronavirus (or other public health risk).

Your Responsibility to Minimize Your Exposure During Rehearsals

The Raleigh Ringers is requesting you agree to take certain precautions which will help keep everyone safer from exposure, illness, and possible death. If you do not adhere to these safeguards, you will be asked to leave.

- You have received the COVID-19 vaccine or have a medical exemption.
- You will only attend if you are symptom free.
- You will only attend if you have been free from fever for a minimum of 10 days prior to the date of the event.
- You will NOT attend if you have been in contact with someone who has tested positive within the last 14 days.
- You will comply with local, state, or federal orders or guidelines for wearing a mask.
- If you test positive for the COVID-19, you will notify The Raleigh Ringers so that all attendees can be notified and take appropriate precautions. (All names will remain confidential.)

The Raleigh Ringers may alter the above precautions if additional local, state, or federal orders or guidelines are published. If that happens, we will notify you about any necessary changes.
